What you need to do immediately**If you agree with the amount due and you're not working with an IRS representative**

- Pay the amount due of \$2,508.30 by January 8, 2024, to avoid additional interest charges.
- Pay online or mail a check or money order with the attached payment stub. **You can pay online now at www.irs.gov/payments.**

If you disagree with the amount due

- Call us at 833-678-7020 to review your account with a representative. Be sure to have your account information available when you call.

We'll assume you agree with the information in this notice if we don't hear from you.

What you need to know

You owe a shared responsibility payment (SRP) because one or more members of your tax household didn't have minimum essential health coverage or didn't qualify for an exemption from coverage, per Internal Revenue Code Section 5000A. The SRP amount that you owe is not subject to a Notice of Federal Tax Lien filing, a levy on your property, or the failure-to-pay penalty. However, we charge interest on unpaid SRP balances. We may also apply your federal tax refunds to the SRP balance until it is paid in full.

Payment options

Pay online, by phone, or with a mobile device. Visit IRS.gov/payments or the IRS2Go mobile app for all IRS payment options.

If you plan to mail a payment, consider the electronic options at IRS.gov/payments first. It's free to pay from a bank account (Direct Pay) or the Electronic Federal Tax Payment System (EFTPS). You can also schedule payments and receive email notifications.

If you pay by check, money order, or cashier's check, make sure it's payable to the U.S. Treasury.
