If you can't pay due to financial hardship

Temporarily delay collection

If you can't pay due to financial hardship, the IRS may temporarily delay collection until your situation improves. Visit **IRS.gov/delay** to learn more. When contacting the IRS, have your financial information (including assets, and monthly income and expenses) available.

Settle your tax debt

An Offer in Compromise could allow you to settle your tax debt for less than the full amount you owe. You can use our online pre-qualifier tool at **IRS.gov/offers** to see if you qualify. Use of the tool does not guarantee offer acceptance.

Consequences if you don't pay

We can file a Notice of Federal Tax Lien (NFTL), notifying your creditors that we have a claim (lien) against all your property. If we file the lien, it may be difficult to sell or borrow against your property.

We may seize (levy) your property or your rights to property if you fail to comply. Property includes wages and other income, bank accounts, business assets, personal assets (including your car and home), Social Security benefits, Alaska Permanent Fund dividends, or state tax refunds.

The U.S. Department of State may revoke your passport or decline to issue or renew a passport if you have seriously delinquent tax debt totaling more than \$62,000. For more information, visit IRS.gov/passports.

Note: For jointly filed returns, we're required to send a copy of this notice to both you and your spouse. Each copy contains the information you are authorized to receive. Only pay the amount due once.



Taxpayer rights and sources for assistance

The Taxpayer Bill of Rights groups these into 10 fundamental rights. See IRC Section 7803(a)(3). IRS employees are responsible for being familiar with and following these rights. The Taxpayer Advocate Service (TAS) is an independent organization within the IRS that helps taxpayers and protects taxpayers' rights. TAS can offer you help if your tax problem is causing a financial difficulty, you've tried but have been unable to resolve your issue with the IRS, or you believe an IRS system, process, or procedure isn't working as it should. Tax professionals who are independent from the IRS may be able to help you.

Low Income Taxpayer Clinics (LITCs) can represent low-income persons before the IRS or in court. LITCs can also help persons who speak English as a second language. Any services provided by an LITC must be for free or a small fee. To find an LITC near you:
